- By default, visa invitation letters will be issued via e-mail unless requested otherwise.

## Weather:

In July, the min/max temperatures in Montreal generally range from 23 °C (73 °F) to 31 °C (88 °F).

## Time Zone:

GMT - 4 hours in July.

### **Currency & Exchange:**

The Canadian currency system uses dollars (\$) and cents ( $\phi$ ) similar to the U.S., Australia and New Zealand. Canada now has one- and two-dollar coins, often called the "loonie" and the "toonie" respectively, in addition to 5¢, 10¢ and 25¢ coins. Paper money comes in different colors and designs. The most common are \$5 bills (blue), \$10 bills (purple), \$20 bills (green), \$50 bills (red) and \$100 bills (brown).
