**Subject:** Follow up with oneM2M on the release of the User Services Platform

We're writing to inform you that the Broadband Forum has recently launched version 1.0 of its User Services Platform (USP), published as TR-369, which be found at <http://usp.technology/specification>. This work represents an evolution of TR-069 (CWMP) that is flexible, scalable, secure, and applicable to a vast number of use cases both legacy and new. This includes more advanced Wi-Fi management and control scenarios, smart hubs and IoT, and more. Our work continues with certification and interoperability test plans, and soliciting organizations that have been diligently working on building standardized IoT service objects to gather data to incorporate into the USP data models. We are planning plugfest activities in Q3 of 2018.

We had a joint call with oneM2M on USP earlier this year. oneM2M TS-0006 currently references TR-069 for management, and we would like oneM2M to consider updating this by including the new protocol as well. We'd be happy to provide more information, and will be hosting additional information sessions and webinars in the future. Please reach out to us with any questions or feedback you may have.
