Check-in is 16:00 on arrival day; Check-out is 12:00 (noon) on departure day. <u>Cancellation Policy: If you are unsure if you will be attending the meetings, please go ahead and book your room now (but no later than June 24) to be guaranteed the negotiated rate</u> because reservations cancelled with <i>at least</i> 48 hours’ notice will not incur any penalty. - Advance submission of applications is recommended.
- By default, visa invitation letters will be issued via e-mail unless requested otherwise.



Practical Information

Weather:

In July, the min/max temperatures in Montreal generally range from 23 °C (73 °F) to 31 °C (88 °F).

Time Zone:

GMT - 4 hours in July.

Currency & Exchange:

The Canadian currency system uses dollars (\$) and cents (¢) similar to the U.S., Australia and New Zealand. Canada now has one- and two-dollar coins, often called the "loonie" and the "toonie" respectively, in addition to 5¢, 10¢ and 25¢ coins. Paper money comes in different colors and designs. The most common are \$5 bills (blue), \$10 bills (purple), \$20 bills (green), \$50 bills (red) and \$100 bills (brown).
