



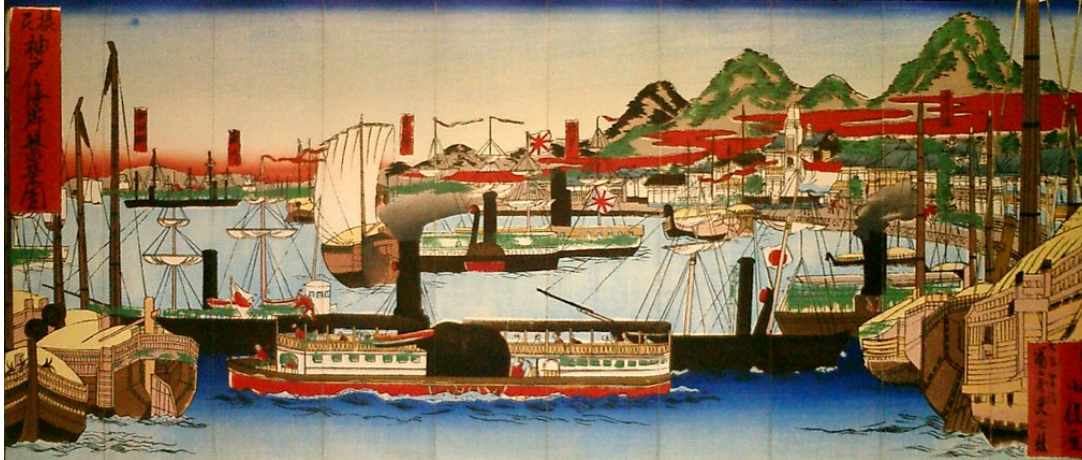

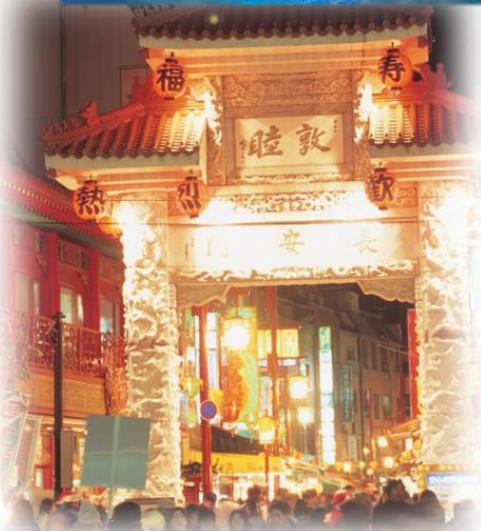

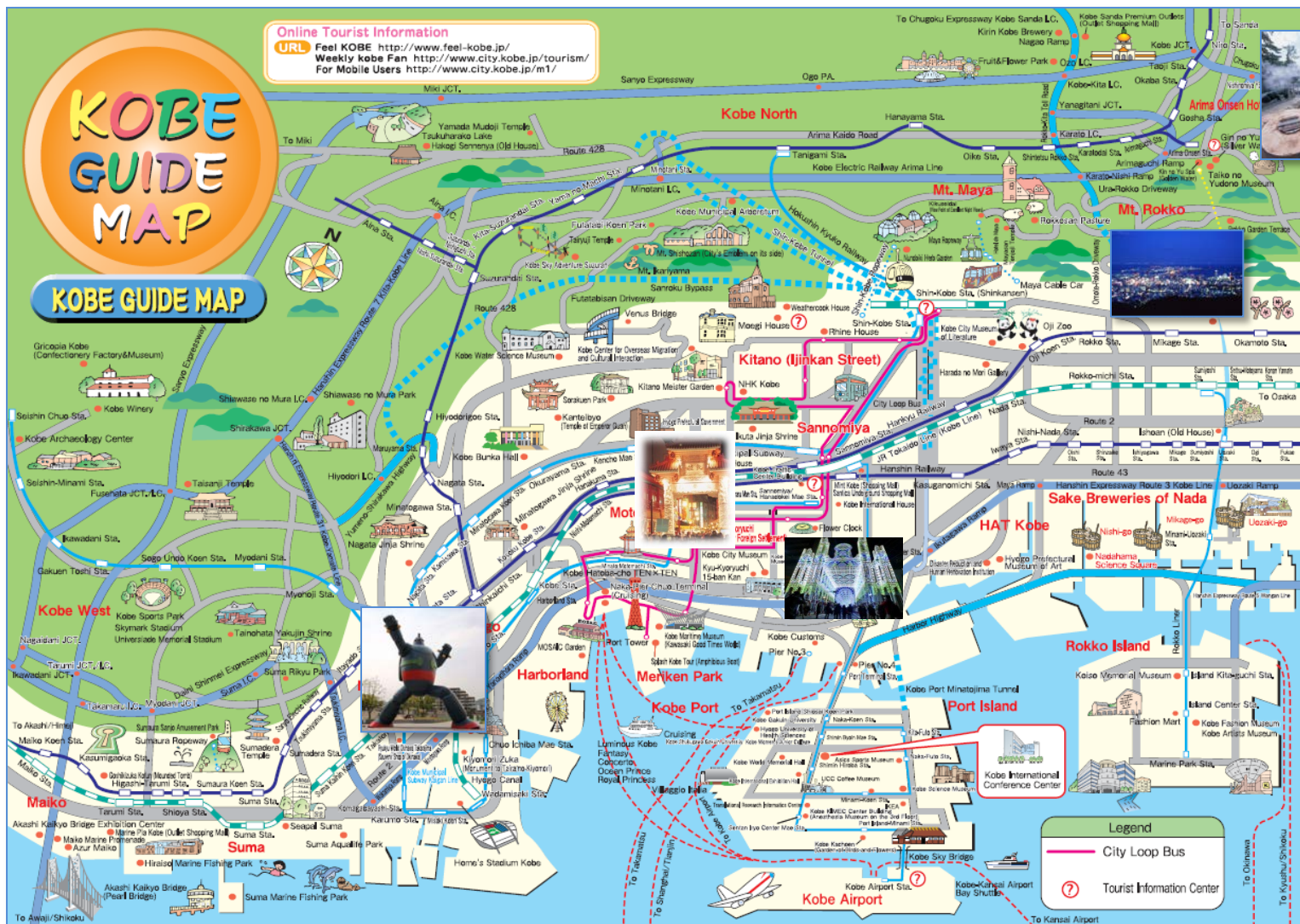

Kobe beef

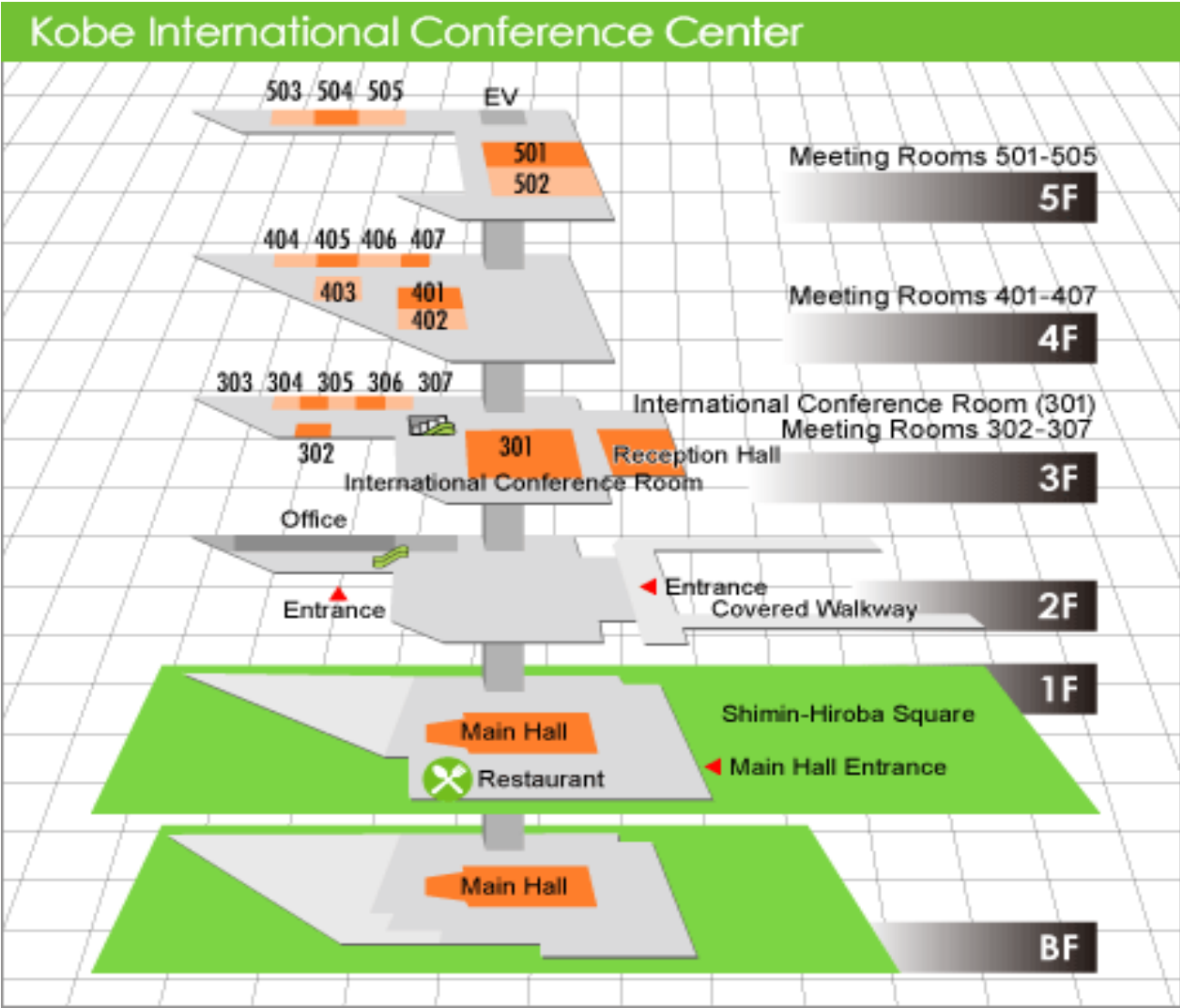

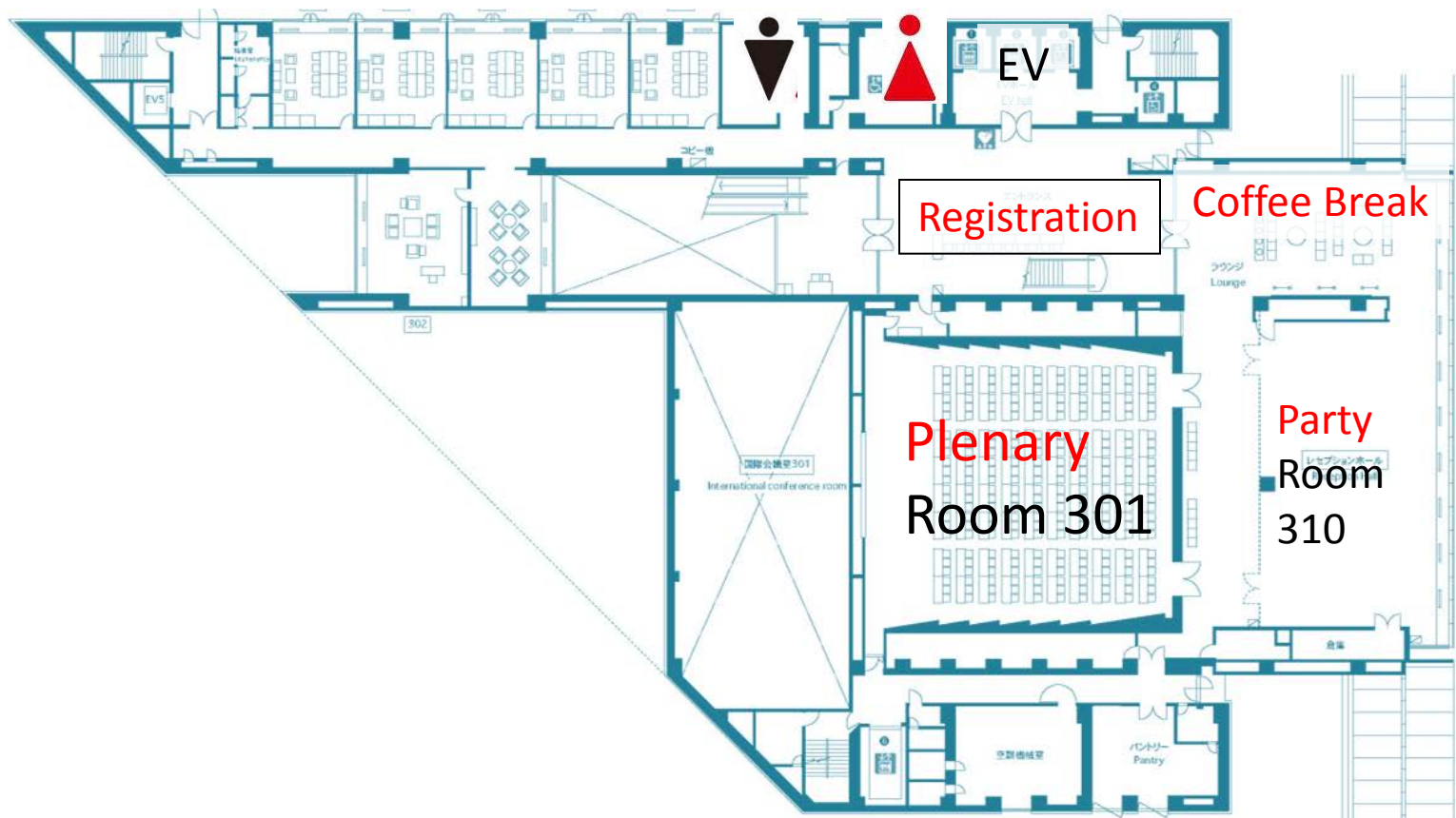

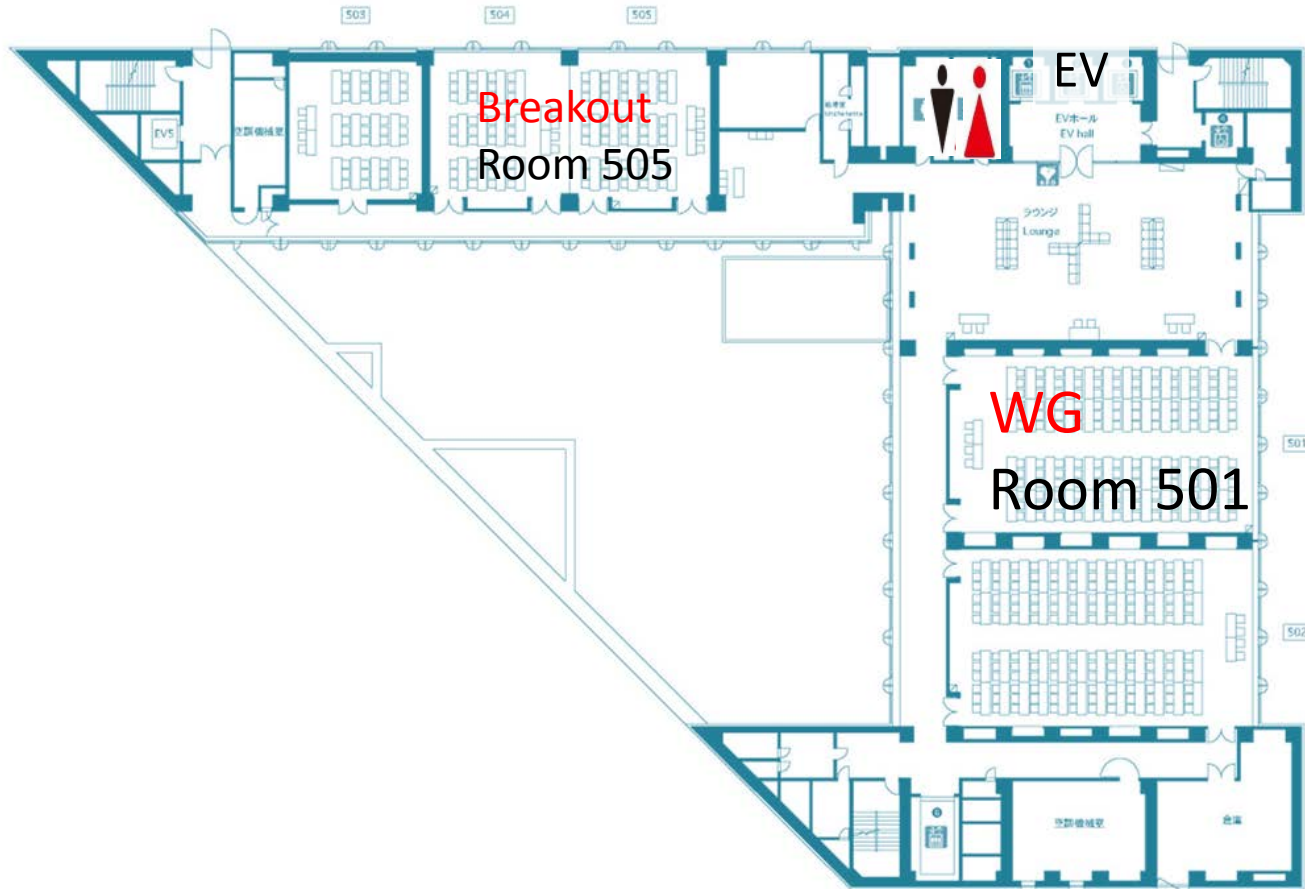
Floors of the conference center
